Thank you for your faithful prayer support. Below is an update on the ministry in Argentina.



GOD did it again! A couple who's been attending our church for about a month, Juan and Miriam, trusted Christ last Sunday! But that's not all...

Alejandro, a church member, had been **witnessing** to them for some time and they agreed to come to church. In the midst of that, another member, Sara, started doing a **Bible study** with the wife. Several people planting the seeds of the Word of God in their lives.

In the meantime, God used a spider to bite Juan's hand so that he couldn't work. As soon as we found out about their need, James and the 2 other families who have been ministering to this couple brought them groceries. Right there at the kitchen table, they **BOTH trusted Christ!**

Does God use His people to bring others to Christ? Yes! Does God use difficult circumstances for people to recognize their need for a Savior? Yes!

Now, Miriam, the wife, will continue studying the Bible with Sara and Juan, the husband, will begin studying with Alejandro.

There are now **67 believers being personally disciplined** on a weekly, bi-weekly or monthly basis at church, in homes and coffee shops.



The Lord has given Lauren a blessed time in Peru so far. She has seen the Lord work in marvelous ways while ministering as well as observing. The Operation Renewed Hope medical campaign ended Friday. Between two small jungle towns, in 4 days, the doctors attended to over 1,000 patients and there were **over 55 professions of faith!**



It seems the best solution for Amy's lumbar herniated disc is laser surgery. Please pray that the surgery would go well and that it will fix the problem so that she can function normally again without so much pain. The surgery is scheduled **Tuesday, May 30 at 5:30 pm EST.**
