We are happy to be writing you again from Valledupar, Cesar, Colombia. The weather here has gone from hot and dry to humid and sticky. We are very thankful that it has rained. Here, the political situation has the government with its eyes on Venezuela.

## Happenings Here

These last couple of months have been quite different here in Colombia. There were several weeks of a prolonged teacher's strike. Many of the kids in public school here were out most all that time.

## Things With Us

We have had a lot of things to keep us busy. We have been going back and forth a bit to Bogotá. There were some legal things to take care of. Also, in a few weeks, I will have to go to renew my passport. Even though, the kids tried to enjoy their' school vacation a bit. The car was delayed in being repaired in part due to holidays here.

## Things With The Church

About the mid part of July, two young men were with us to have an activity for kids. Their names are Ben and Nelson. One is from PR and the other is from California. They both were a great blessing. One afternoon, 67 kids attended. They all heard the gospel and had a wonderful time. There were more than ten that responded to the invitations to receive the Lord.

## Struggles

Still, we are struggling with the influences of other churches and bad doctrine. Some are groups that are G-12, United Pentecostal (Jesus Only), and several that are Charismatic and Pentecostal. We are constantly encountering the doctrines of financial prosperity, baptismal regeneration, errors of women pastors, and the lack of eternal security.

Recently, a Pentecostal group has been having services in a house in front of the Church. They use a loud P.A. system that makes it hard for us to hear. Also, in a few days the Pope will be visiting Colombia. We fear that will mean the release of some of Colombia's most dangerous criminals.
