T Soon after the 10th anniversary, we were able to host a pastor’s training conference with Faith Baptist Church, Tacoma Washington. There were close to 170 pastors that attended this four-day meeting. What a blessing it was to be able to brush shoulders with these men who have dedicated their lives to preach the Word of God. They received Bibles, New Testaments, John and Romans and three different tracts to be personalized with their own church’s information.

D The last day of the conference was dedicated to soul-winning. We were able to go a town called “Paradise” and pass out these same materials that we received and share the gospel. Our goal was to reach the town in one day with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Well, we believe that we covered almost all of Paradise that day and saw God do a miraculous work. There are around 50,000 people that live in this city and on that day 242 people made professions of faith.



U The following Sunday, the 23rd of July, Faith Baptist Church was planted. An amazing first service was recorded. Eighty-eight people from Paradise came to the service and 42 from the church in Danli, for a total of about 130 people. We are now praying for a more permanent place to meet. At the moment, the services are in a local hotel, but the logistics are getting more difficult. We are looking this week at some different properties. Please pray with us for God’s leading.

R God answered our prayers for a new bus. In our last letter we showed a picture of a new bus that we were able to buy here in Honduras to replace one that was cemetery bound. Well, God not only blessed with the funds for one bus, but we were able to buy another bus in the States and have it brought down to Honduras. It arrived last week and we have already started using it in the ministry.
