Dear Friends and Family,

Let me start off by saying Merry Christmas to everyone! We want to give thanks to God for all the preaching, teaching and ministry He has allowed us to do the past few months. We had the privilege of having a Creation ministry come and teach at Grace just last month. We had alot of visitors and were able to give the gospel to them. Pieta, a visitor to the church, who was already saved but had never been baptized followed the Lord in baptism and joined the church. Unfortunately, I had to do two funerals within the same immediate family back to back. A grown brother and sister in their 50's and 60's passed away within a week of each other. The family is obviously heartbroken. On a positive note our church was able to love and to witness to well over 50 people through this tragedy.

A homeless man, named Wayne that was a drug addict came by the church one day about 1yr ago. He wanted to sleep in the enclosed yard of the church as he said it was safer than just sleeping on the street. He said he gets beat up and robbed if he just sleeps out on the street. I told him to come inside and tell me his story. He told how he use to have a beautiful home and family but threw it all away because of drugs. I explained the gospel to him and asked him to come to church that night. After the service another man in the church shared the gospel with him. He made a profession of faith and the leaders in the church agreed to allow him to sleep in a Sunday school room. That was the beginning of some crazy experiences. One day he took me to meet his children. Right before we got out of the car to go into their house, I made sure and asked if we were doing anything wrong and he assured me we were not. I left a little note for their mom, Natalie, to let us know if we could pick the kids up for church. We left and that was that. A few hours later my phone started getting lit up with not so nice messages. They were threats and warnings from the mom for bringing Wayne near the kids and her house while she was not there. I apologized and explained how we were trying to help Wayne. Well...Wayne didn't turn out. He was doing his drugs in our Sunday school room and pawned a few of our church belongings. He was gone but we continued to pray for him and his family. Out of the blue, Natalie texted me and asked if she could come to church! Just a few weeks back she made a profession of faith and her 12yr old boy and his cousin are going to Camp Rhino with us next week! Please pray for this single mother and her two beautiful children, neither of which know the Lord.

We praise the Lord for what we have seen Him do this year. Fifteen people have followed the Lord in baptism just in Grace Baptist Church alone. Two young preachers are growing, studying and gaining more and more experience in the church. We are moving closer and closer to being able to start a new ministry in the nearby Kuyga township. Please keep all of these things in your prayers.

We thank you for your generous care and concern for our family. We are unworthy but grateful. Pray for Camp Rhino coming up Dec 11th - 15th. We have 15 campers ready to go!
