If life is a vapor what is a month to be compared to? Time goes by so quickly. We just finished up our children's holiday club or VBS. This is one of our greatest weeks of the year as people are serving, the gospel is preached, and children and youth are being saved.

We ran our VBS from July 10-14th. Kindergarten through 7th grade met from 8am-12pm in the morning, Monday-Friday. Grades 9-12 met in the evening from 6-8pm, Monday through Friday. We passed approximately 3500 invitations in schools, to individuals, and door to door. We had a great response with approximately 150 kids and youth attending over the course of the week.

Our people were incredible! Some were at the church as early as 7am each morning and stayed as late as 9pm in the evenings. It was a beautiful thing to see many of our newer people at Grace catching the attitude of a servant. We really stress that the greatest at Grace are the ones that are serving others the most! It was great to see this in action during the week!



We had the awards program on Friday night and saw many new parents and grandparents come. We are currently busy following up on the parents of the children. We have had some great visits in the homes. Just yesterday we got invited into a home and were able to share the gospel with a mother and father. The father was tearing up by the end of the conversation. No decisions were made but the seed was planted.

We visited another family who has four little girls. The father has had two heart attacks and is only 41yrs old. They came to the service this morning, were under conviction, and are coming to our house on Tuesday night because they want to know more! Pray for Dennis and Sheri to get saved. In total we saw about 10 people make professions of faith during the week! Pray for these families that we would have wisdom and be able to reach them for Christ over the next few weeks!

We are needing to make room for growth and we praise the Lord for that. We are currently making plans to enlarge the sanctuary by taking out to small rooms. The cost of the project with the latest quote we have received is \$5,000.
