Greetings in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ,

As we prepare to celebrate Resurrection Sunday, we lift up the One Who saved us and uses us. It still amazes Jerilyn and me that we have the privilege to go to India and Myanmar as ambassadors for Jesus.

**INDIA** As I have reported in previous prayer letters, **Nambike Baptist Church's** big soul winning effort in November is Dharu Jhatra and we have seen hundreds bow their hearts and heads to ask Jesus to be their Saviour. Humanly speaking, we often wonder what affect are we really having on these folks. They come from other villages and we may never see them on this side of Glory again. A week before we departed from India in January, we received a call from the daughter of a lady who had stopped by our tent in November. Her daughter stated that her mother got saved while visiting us and she started out to continue to go on this pilgrimage. She started, but the Holy Spirit reminded her that she did not have to go to some event for grace; she received all she needed for heaven at the cross of Calvary. She turned around and headed home! The daughter called us because her mother wanted to follow the Lord, in believers' baptism. Praise the Lord I had the privilege to baptize her. The Lord used her to encourage all of us who are involved in this annual soul winning effort.

More progress is being made on the church property at **Niricksha Baptist Church**. The compound wall and gate have been completed, as well as plastering and painting. Work on the second story is beginning. A battlement will be placed around the entire second floor and the tent, that has been their faithful auditorium for years, will be placed over it until the Lord provides the need funds for the roof, windows, and doors. There will also be a railing in place up the stairwell. Children's Church will now be able to be held on the first floor set out, instead of under a tree!

Pastor Raju also reported that eight folks had been saved and baptized since our departure. They will be having their Vacation Bible School the end of April/ May time frame.

**Sandeep Samuel** also reported that he continues to distribute Bibles in villages and is taking courses through our extension program of Didasko Baptist Bible Institute.

**MYANMAR Pastor PaLian** reports that he was able to purchase a motor cycle with funds the Lord had provided and has been able to extend his church's outreach. His daughter, who graduated from Bethel Baptist Bible Institute a few years ago, travels with him for child evangelism and Sunday School in nearby villages. His wife Vung Sen has been able to manage the small village shop for tamays (women's basic skirting) and basic food stuffs. The income is sufficient for PaLian's family needs. He provides a day by day account of every home and hospital visit, with the needs related to those visits. This last year, he reported that two precious souls were saved. He is a faithful servant in a difficult fundamental Buddhist area.
