

While I am stopped in traffic because of an overturned garlic truck, I thought that I would pen what has been happening.

We are still awaiting permission though all documents have been finished and all payments have been made. The only thing left to do is wait on the Lord and pray that He will work in the hands of corrupt officials who are awaiting bribes. As we wait, more monies have come in toward our construction. Now would be a good time to build because Brazil is in a financial crisis. Prices are low and workers available.

Some years ago, I went through an Indian reservation at the base of a mountain overlooking São Paulo. The children were loving and wanting attention. I thought, "It would be nice to be able to work here and see at least a children's Bible club started." I prayed that God would work there. A few weeks ago, I was talking with another missionary, who I knew had a ministry among the Indian, he said that that is where he is ministering. They have about 25 children and 14 adults in attendance. I thought that you would like to hear of an answer to prayer.

Some of you are praying for Ribamar and Pablo's father. Ribamar is working and hasn't been drinking. He has been attending church. Not-only has been attending church, but-also has requested home Bible studies. God answers prayer. Please continue to pray for these men from the Carapicuíba ministry.

My teen girls have been sucking up the Word. They have seen what God desires of godly women and homes. As a result, they have seen needs within their own family units. This dovetails nicely with our upcoming evangelistic meetings that will include a secession from men and for women on the home. I'll have the children during this time.

We have a little rug-a-muffin coming regularly. He told me, "My brother is flying a kite, but I'd rather be here." He comes from a large Catholic family. Last night, he asked, "am I going to be with you and the boys?" His response to my, "yes" was, "yeah."

My furlough is approaching at the end of this year, and I already have teachers waiting to take my place. In fact, I believe that I have at least three wanting my teen girls.
