Memorizing verses is an important part of our pre-school Bible class every day. In addition to reciting verses, we also sing the verses to help the students learn them and are constantly reviewing all the verses we have learned. Recently in a meeting with a parent, he mentioned that his daughter is constantly quoting the first verse we learned in pre-school – Romans 3:23 (“For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God”). The children also passed out fliers to our Easter Sunrise Service. The Lord blessed their efforts with a packed church, and an opportunity for many to hear God’s Word. The Easter emphasis continued the next day when we had our annual All Night Girls Class. The girls studied “the colors of Easter” from God’s Word and had a fun night of fellowship and special activities.

The Junior Quiz Masters (ages 6-11) are continuing to study God’s Word with a new series on the Parables of Jesus. About twenty-five children have been coming faithfully on Wednesday nights and most are not saved. I started with the “lost” parables and am praying that the children will “hear” God’s Word and be “found.” Our verse is “If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.” (Mark 4:23)

God’s Word is being spread, and I look forward to seeing how God will use it to “accomplish” His purpose here in Grenada.
