Fall has finally arrived and we are exhaling after a busy season of travel. Our summer months were packed with tens of thousands of miles, thousands of patients, hundreds of volunteers and blessings too numerous to count. We hiked mountains, traversed jungles, viewed safari sunsets and felt wind, sun and rain on our faces, but most importantly we helped multiple churches share the love of Christ in a tangible way.

June found us on the remote island of Vanuatu, located in the South Pacific with veteran missionary Jeremy Pinero. Our team of 41 volunteers worked alongside Luganville Baptist Church and attended to 2,535 patients and had 811 professions of faith. After a quick turn around, we left the tropics and headed to South America. For the third time, Medical Missions Outreach partnered with veteran missionary Jason Holt in Santiago, Chile. It was winter in the Southern hemisphere, but despite the cold our team of 48 members worked hard to attend to 1,588 patients and saw 341 professions of faith.

In early July MMO returned to Nicaragua to partner with five different pastors and five churches. Our team of 63 volunteers worked in a small, rural clinic, while the vision team utilized a nearby barn. In all, we attended to 2,110 patients and had 86 professions of faith. Many of these patients were transported in from a local dump where homeless people live amongst the refuse, collecting plastic to trade in for coins. Late July found our team of 37 in Nyahururu, Kenya with national pastor Philip Waruture. Our partnership with Bible Baptist Church enabled us to treat 1,727 patients with 45 professions of faith.

From Kenya we returned to the US to repack and pick up our new team before heading back to Africa- this time on the West side. Our team of 20 volunteers worked in the village of Motobe, Ivory Coast with national pastor Pasquel, with the goal of establishing a new church plant.

The last trip of the year was to Morogoro, Tanzania to work with missionary Jerry Wyatt and the people of Faith Baptist Church. Working
