A while back we had the privilege to honor one of our long time members with a surprise birthday party! He will be moving in the near future and will be missed. Right now, we are enjoying our new house. We have spent long hours trying to finish up the details, split wood for the inside stoves and move all that we accumulated over the past 9



years in Canada from a larger place to a medium size building. In spite of all the work, we opened the mission on October 9th with a Thanksgiving Dinner. I believe we fed close to 20.

Unfortunately, our service attendance remains low. But we remain open and welcoming. Bob is still preaching 3 times a week at Friendship Baptist Church and is teaching the Bible Club lesson. It took a while to hear back from the town regarding Bible Club, but through prayer, we were granted 2 Saturdays a month with no fee because it is a community service. So we started Bible club on October 21.



The girls from Cindy’s class came over one day and helped stack wood and then enjoyed Hot chocolate on the porch. The Girls Class officially started on October 12th with a simple game night and short challenge. It turned into a question time and a follow-up lesson on Heaven. In turn, that discussion brought in questions on transgender issues and Heaven. Kids today are being bombarded
