Dear friends and supporters,

We want to start by saying thank you to all that financially give for toward the ministry here in Nepal. Over the last few years there has been ups and downs, times of discouragement and times of real victory. Through it all, we can look back and see God's hand working in every situation. The last 3 months have been challenging as we have been and continue to seek the Lord's will for the next step of the ministry here in Nepal. During this time we have seen the Lord working in the Children's Home ministry and we have seen great progress in Baitadi and Surkhet. We are excited at what God is doing as we wait on him about the next steps.

Children's Home: We reported to you in our last letter that Rekman, Bisal, and Suman all made professions of faith. The Lord continues to work as 2 of our girls have now also accepted Christ as their Savior. Mary came after Bible class one day and said she wanted to be saved. I asked her why she needed to be saved. Her eyes began to swell with tears as she answered that she was a sinner and that she did bad things. I ask why she was sinner she said that she was born a sinner but that she would do bad things. She proclaimed that she knew that Jesus would forgive her sin and give her a new heart and that her only hope was in Jesus Christ. I sat and listened as Mary, through tears, confessed her sinful condition and told the Lord she was sorry for her sin and the pain it caused him and called on the name of Jesus and ask him to save her soul. The next day when Sandy arrived at the school. Mary came to her, beaming from ear to ear, and said "Hajuraama (grandma) I am going to heaven, Jesus has given me a new heart and I am saved." Oh, what a change we have seen in Mary. About a couple of weeks later Unisha came and said she wanted to be saved. We are not always sure about Unisha and what goes on with her and what she knows and doesn't know. As I began to take the Bible and show Unisha the word it became very clear that Unisha knew exactly what sin was and that she herself was a sinner and she needed the only one who could save her Jesus Christ to come into her heart. Again, I had the privilege to listen to the sweet voice of a young girl, through tears, admit her lost condition, and turn in repentance and faith to Jesus Christ, calling on him to come into her heart. Again, what a change we have seen in Unisha. What a honor to represent you here in Nepal and to share the gospel on your behalf to the people of Nepal. To add fruit to your account in heaven. Thank you for letting us be here to preach the gospel. Please continue to pray for the rest of the children – Rona, Ashish, Jebika, Jabar, and Nirmal. Please pray for our house Parents – Philemon and Karuna – as they serve the Lord and care for the children day to day.

Baitadi, Far West Nepal: Rajendra and Esther have been doing well. We were with them in April as I preached the missions conference at Sancho Shanti Baptist Church. They have faced some adversity but the church is growing. In fact, they have had several people call on the name of the Lord and be saved and recently they baptized 6 people. We are thankful for the growth of this ministry and for the work that Rajendra and Esther are doing. It won't be long until the church is standing on its own. Please pray for their continued growth and strength.

Surkhet, Midwest Nepal: Top and Mena are also doing well. About 3 months ago Top had a wreck on his motorcycle going out to the village work in Masina. A truck came over on him and pinned his bike and him against the mountain wall. It messed up his leg and hand. He was in a cast for some time but is doing better now. The church in Surkhet is also doing well, they also have seen several saved and recently baptized 5. What a blessing to have worked with these men over the last 4 years.

Kathmandu: There is a great need here in the capital city of Nepal. Please pray as we continue to tell others about the great love of Jesus Christ. Pray for the next steps for the ministry. Our desire is to know the mind of the Lord and do his will not ours. Until then we will continue to share the gospel with those around us. Please pray for our next-door neighbor that we have been witnessing to and shows an interest in learning more.
