Dear Friends and Supporters:

The first quarter of 2018 was an eventful one. God always does more than we think He will. I have learned as missionary that we work hard but leave the results up to God. Someone even said, "Work like everything depends on you, but trust like everything depends on God." In these last days we need to work harder than we ever did in the service of the Lord, and leave the results to Him.

MISSIONS CONFERENCE – We were blessed to have a wonderful missions conference here this past March. We had friends in the ministry to come preach here at our church. Dr. Armie Jesalva, Dr. Gerry Nable and Evangelist Jeff Welch. Dr. Ron White was supposed to be here, but was suffering from back problems, so please pray for him. God really worked in the hearts of His people here and the faith promise missions commitment went up to a record high for us. The Filipino people are so eager and excited to share Jesus Christ with a lost world, and while they don't have much by western standards, in many ways, spiritually-speaking, they have much more. Our theme this year was, "This could be the Final Harvest". Two weeks later my home church Pastor, Dr. James Rushing, Jr. spent a week this us to preach in the Bible College graduation, and organize the church here.

CAMPUS MINISTRY UPDATE – God blessed our prayer to be able get inside the universities. Through many open doors we were able to formally get into the local teacher's college by forming a new student organization. Since the university is state-run, we are now able to spread quickly to the other campuses which are also state colleges, holding Bible studies inside each campus. National leadership is an integral part of missions, and so we are training our youth leaders and young men to get into these universities, and share the gospel with the students, get them baptized and disciplined. Pray as more doors open for the gospel in the colleges and also on the high school campuses.

LIVING BY FAITH – These past few month we have been stopping to pray at 10PM for the specific need for our church to have its own property. Wherever we are at 10PM we simply stop and pray for this special need. The urgency for this has increased as the landlord of the rental property we are on wants to sell it to us by July. We are in the process now of paperwork and banks, etc. This is all by faith, as we know that God's ministry, done God's way, never lacks God's supply. Our people here are humble, hardworking people who have a great desire to see souls saved just as they have been saved. We are trusting God to provide the remainder for our down payment which will be about \$40,000USD. Please join us in prayer for this need. If we cannot raise the money for the down payment, we will have to uproot and leave the rental property we are on now, but we are earnestly praying to buy it. God knows our need, and He always provides for His children.

SUMMER SEASON – Summer here is very busy as I am preaching in a youth camp or conference about every week. I never knew that answering God's call to be preacher would lead me down this path, but I am honestly just enjoying the ride. I preached for Pastor Edgar Nono in Negros Island on the first week of April and there 80 professions of Christ, and over 750 campers. I was also privileged to preach for Dr. Armie Jesalva at their Youth Congress to about 1,150 delegates. What a great honor to be a preacher of the gospel! I count it a great privilege and responsibility. Therefore, I do covet your prayers for power, protection and purity in my life and ministry. Our own youth camp will be Apr.30-May 4, 2018, so please do pray for my youth group, that many will decide to follow Christ and surrender for full-time ministry.
