Dear Friends,

First of we apologize that this letter is late in coming. We did not realize the time had gone by so quickly.



We were able to host our Easter Sunrise Service and Brunch this year. Though many of our people were out of town we had a good group of regulars and some visitors as well. We also had a baptism, and our niece, Brianna, was baptized.



We had the opportunity to visit some of our former LMCS missionary teachers who have moved to the high mountain town of Ayavirí to share the Gospel with the 400 people who live there. The trip was intense with about 3 hours of driving in fog on a narrow, rough road. To one side was a drop off of several thousand feet and to the other the high mountain. Through that rough stretch of road there was no cellphone service available, few small scattered villages and very few other vehicles.



We did a lot of praying!

We loved being in Ayavirí and helping with a Bible Club, meeting people around town and visiting with the two missionary families. The work there is slow, but recently a few of the villagers have accepted Christ as their Savior. It was a great experience for us.



One of our graduates from LMCS met an American teacher at her university. His family started coming to our English church and soon invited a neighbor to our Spanish church. Flor made a decision to accept Christ and a few weeks ago she was baptized along with 3 other people. It is encouraging to see how God puts the right people in the right place. We are thrilled to see how God is using some of our students and graduates.
