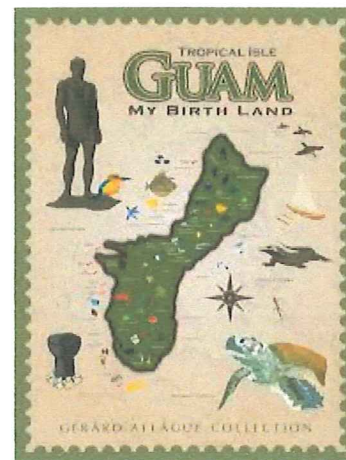
It has been slow beginnings with the military, and Terry and Rita Pike will continue to strive to reach servicemen and women for Christ.
