As I was talking to him and telling him how God could use his life he told me he wanted to get saved. I was stunned. I went back over the Gospel with him and right there on the way home Vumi, in the simplest and most sincere way asked Christ to save him! I look forward to seeing what God will use this young man to do!



I am going to ask something unusual of our friends and supporters. We have South African missionary friends, The Bonds Family, that have been serving faithfully and without any recognition and very little help for over a decade. They are a solid family of like faith and practice. Here is a short note from them explaining their family and ministry:

"We have 14 people in our family. We adopted my wife's sister, Jessie, after her parents past away. We also have 4 biological children, 6 other adopted children and 1 foster child. Our 2 older children have married. Jessie has gone on to adopt 4 children, the parents of which, died 2 years back. We have helped Jessie by converting a large outside building into a little apartment for her, helping her carry the load of being a single parent of children between the ages of 6 and 15. We felt the Lord calling us to go to the little town of Klerksdorp, to minister amongst the beautiful colored people in a specific area there called Alabama. After getting peace and direction from the Lord I resigned my job and sold our home to move there in 2007. We planted a church and it has been a tent making ministry. I have stayed employed working very long hours each week. About 7 years ago, the company I worked for went insolvent. During that year I did odd jobs. But we still had to sell everything that was of value to keep our home. I was encouraged by others to move back to Johannesburg where there are more opportunities and higher salaries. But we never felt it was what the Lord wanted. We knew He wanted us here in Klerksdorp, shining the light of the gospel in the darkness! We have since also started a Christian school. We now have 85 kids. We serve the Lord by faith and He has been very good to us. Thank you for any help with purchasing the vehicle we desperately need at this time. May God bless you!"
