We thank the Lord to once again be in contact with you from Valledupar, Cesar, Colombia. The weather here has been hot, windy, and dry. It has not rained in two months. We are hoping it will soon and cool things off.

The Political Process

On the political front there are a lot of things going on. Not only is this an election year, but this year has a presidential election. It seems that a lot of people here get really tied up in that. Also, in the month of February, the second largest guerilla group (the ELN) has been attacking in our department of Cesar. This has had quite an impact on the folks here that about a decade ago had to live through many terrifying things like that.

A Present Danger

The ELN called for a blockade on the major highways across the country. The hardest hit was the southern part of the department of Cesar. A section of highway and an important bridge were destroyed. Since that time, the people here have changed their habits about being outside and on the streets. Also, there is a greater number of people from Venezuela. Actually, there is an exodus of Venezuelans looking for food.

Things In The Church

The last couple of months also have also been a vacation time for most people here. We continue to evangelize, disciple, and train others for the work of the ministry. One lady accepted the Lord as we were evangelizing on the streets.

Brother Simeon and his family have finished book 1 of the discipleship. Also, another family will soon finish book 1 and they too will be able to share what they have learned. A young man from Cartagena named Luis Enrique has come to help us in the work here. He has plans to get married and ordained in July.

Finding Time To Do Some Things

Thank the Lord, I was able to go to Bogotá and get my passport renewed. I have had bronchitis for the last few weeks. Thank the Lord, Bro. Simeon has helped us with medicines. Several others have been sick in the Church. In my case, I eventually went to a pneumologist. It has been slow, but thank the Lord, I have gotten better.

A Trial For A Family

About two weeks ago a sister of the Church here in Valledupar was crossing a busy street and was run over by a motorcycle. She was seriously injured with a blow to her head. The man driving the motorcycle died of his injuries. We thank everyone that has been praying. She is at home now and is slowly getting better. She is still in a lot of pain.
