Dear Pastor and praying friends,

THANK YOU for all your special prayers for us during this three-month emergency furlough. It was a BLESSING to get to be with family for my Mother's funeral services.

We praise God for safety in travels to Tennessee, Texas, Ohio, and Michigan. Our hearts have been touched by the kindness and fellowship with dear prayer partners in several of our supporting churches.

As you know, even though we are only in our sixties we may be facing going into "unknown" territory. The government is not so willing to renew visas for the missionaries who are now in South Africa. We may have to do 90 days at a time, and travel into Botswana for 3 weeks in-between, to work with another mission church there.
