## Dearest Brethren Who Work In Faith And Labor In Love,

We are glad to have the opportunity once again to come to you in the form of this letter. We trust that the Lord's blessings and divine guidance have been with you. Here in Valledupar, we have seen very hot days with high humidity. Several days the temperature has gone over 100 degrees. Due to an dengue of dengue our area was fumigated. That helped a lot. The political situation has been stable as President Duque has begun his term in office.

## Colombia and Venezuela

There is an ever increasing number of people coming in from Venezuela. Most, say very little against the Venezuelan government as they are afraid of what may happen to their families and friends that are still there. Of those who are willing to say something, they hope that economic pressure from other countries will contribute to peacefully ending what they are living out there. Children are dying from malnutrition. President Duque recently in an interview with BBC stated that there are 800,000 Venezuelans here and that if the dictatorship doesn't end, the migration will not stop. Tensions are building between the government of Colombia and Venezuela. He hopes that the OAS will stand with Colombia in this effort.

## Something Unexpected

At the beginning of July, thieves stole the air conditioner of the Church. We thank the Lord, that was the first and only time we have ever had anything like that to happen. We still have classrooms that need air conditioners.

## In The Church

At the beginning of July, a Pastor was with us for a few days. My sister in-law also spent a couple of weeks with us. One day while evangelizing, they spoke to a man named Juan who several months ago had been in a serious motorcycle accident that has almost cost him the loss of his leg. They were able to share the gospel with him and he accepted the Lord. He is travelling to Barranquilla to see when he can have reconstructive surgery on his leg. Please pray for him.

I received the opportunity to teach in another Church. We visited the Church in Monquirá, Boyacá, where I was asked to speak.

## Present & Future Plans

Beginning in August, We decided to have a Thursday Night weekly service in Bro. Simeon's house with Pastor Luis Enrique taking on that responsibility.
