September/October 2018

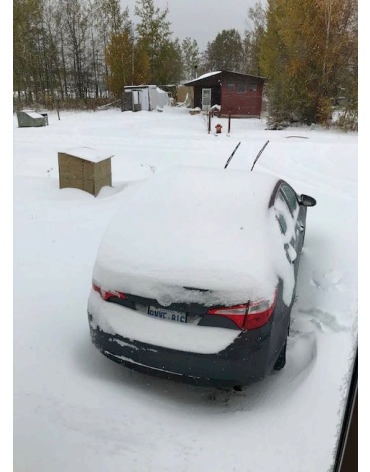
We have been blessed:

It’s been quite a while since our last update. Most of our summer projects are finished. Including the Pastor’s House. Some projects are temporary fixes until next year. We just ran out of time. Our first snow arrived early, dumping more than 6” of snow in 24 hours. Some has melted and a little is coming down even now. Unfortunately, our wood isn’t all in for the upcoming season. There are arrangements to get it this next week. The last three weeks involved three medical trips to Thunder Bay and Sioux Lookout. What happened!?! Cindy accidentally fell while setting pallets down in our newly constructed wood shed. Her wrist was badly broken and had to be airlifted out. Surgery was necessary and a lengthy recovery



time ordered. It was distressing for her since this is a busy time with children’s ministries and wood cutting season. We feel we need to change things up and cut wood in the spring. It would be such a blessing to us for a group of young men to come for a few days to be a blessing in this way. Please think and pray about it.

Children’s Bible Club began September 29th with 15 kids. We also began a new after school program called, “The Safe Zone” for kids 10 and up.



We have had 10 different kids come to play games, have a snack and hang out. We open up our home from 3:10-5:30 Tuesday-Thursday. We hope to incorporate a Friday Night outside activity with the help of friends who have more energy than we do.

We continue to open the mission twice a week but have missed the past few times with medical appointments. When we were open, one lady said that they missed us when we are not here. That’s always an encouragement.



Lastly, there has been a tragic death in the community regarding bad drugs brought into this area. Our neighbor is a suspect in this investigation. We so pray for Justice and for God to remove those who would bring destruction into our community. What a dark day we live in!
