"Pastor I thought you would like to know that I ran into Sam today and asked him if he had accepted Jesus Christ as his Saviour yet." He said that Sam, with a great big smile said, "Yes I did!" Boyed asked Sam when did he accept Christ into his heart and Sam said, "Just about a year ago." My what a Thanksgiving Day! God afflicted my soul with Sam and since 2010 I've not missed a day praying for him. It pays to pray!
