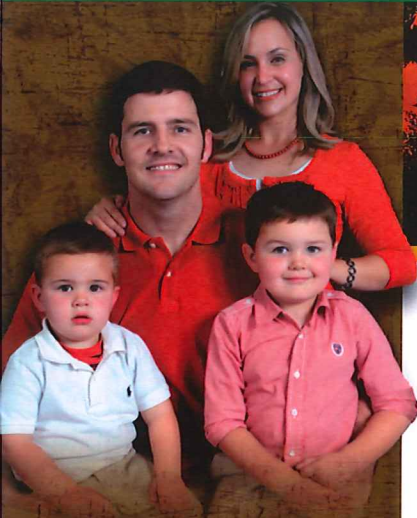


THE HALL Family
