We have the report for the year 2018. This is what took place in our ministry here on the mission field. There were **710** salvation decisions throughout the ministries of our church, and **108** followed in baptism. Included in that report are 104 who were saved between November to December last year and 15 who were baptized. We rejoice and praise God for His work and working in our lives to bring forth fruit. Thank you, each and every one of you, who pray for and support this ministry by your finances. One day we will all rejoice together in Heaven for being co-laborers in the harvest fields. We might be surprised in Heaven and ask, “Lord, when saw we thee... and gave thee..?..and the King shall answer...Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these..ye have done it unto me” - Matt.25:37,40. We will see all the faces of those you and I have prayed for and gave toward so that they might be saved.

In December our church was able to pass out **8,491** John and Romans and over **10,000** Christmas tracts in surrounding and extended areas of the church. In December we also had a nice Christmas dinner for students of a small medical university that is nearby. The students are mostly from India, Africa and islands of the Caribbean. Eighty of them came and a few got saved. Our church also enjoyed going Christmas caroling at the university. Our Christmas Eve candlelight and lantern service went very well as did the Watch Night service on Old Year’s Eve.
