Pastor Pedro and New Life Baptist Church are seeing God's blessings as well. This area has many transient people that work in the coffee crops. However, they have seen people saved every week and the church is steadily growing in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Brother Jerry and Faith Baptist Church are in their second year of ministry. This church is in a city of about 50,000 people and is in a great location. However, we are renting the space at the moment and it is just one room. We need our own property and church. Please pray with us for the ministry in Paradise, Honduras.

Pastor Josue and Bethlehem Baptist Church grew tremendously while we were in the States. The month of December was filled with many activities such as a baptismal service, several Christmas events and the annual Christmas singing in central park. Several families came and decided to stay and join the church. Several people made professions of faith and are trying to serve the Lord.



Then, in January of this year we were able to conduct our sixth youth camp. This year there were about 95 teenagers that attended the week of camp and about 20 adult workers to make the camp a success. Five teenagers made professions of faith in Christ and several made commitments to the Lord during the services.
