Happy New Year from everyone here at the Caribbean Radio Lighthouse on Antigua! As with most of you, Christmas time was busy for all of us at the Lighthouse with different Christmas activities and transitioning to our Christmas programming and back to our regular programming in January. We and our listeners always enjoy the joy and celebration heard in our Christmas music and programs!

In our last letter, we spoke about the need to install a satellite dish to receive a better stream of our Spanish programming (instead of via internet) for our Spanish listeners. In December, we received all the needed equipment, and we installed the new dish. We're still working through a few timing tweaks, but we're excited to be using the new system and praying that it will be better for our listeners and less

work for CRL management.

Another project that has been on the to-do list for some time was to better the walkway between our two ministry apartments. Unfortunately, a cistern overflow and rainwater cross the path of the walkway. We've had many temporary bridges and stones, but still visitors seem to slip in the walkway. With the many teams planning to come and even the need for a wheelchair to cross, we decided to make a more permanent sidewalk with drain pipes underneath. Soon after, we had the MTT (Make a Timothy Today) team return to Antigua for two and half weeks to minister in many of our churches. And in January, we were able to house two Child Evangelism Fellowship workers at they taught courses in Antigua for two weeks.

We continue to pray and make the need known for additional missionary personnel to replace the Kirklands, who will be leaving Antigua in August. Please pray with us as we talk and work with any individuals interested.

Sometimes it's not easy to write a prayer letter about what's going on at CRL, because often just keeping up with daily duties to keep the radio going is our work! I'm very thankful for our committed staff and their love for our listeners. For over a year now, we've had one listener call almost daily, to seek encouragement and prayer for depression. She recently told me, "You are my family. You are always there to pray with me and for me." Thank you also for praying and supporting this ministry and in turn loving on our listeners, as well.
