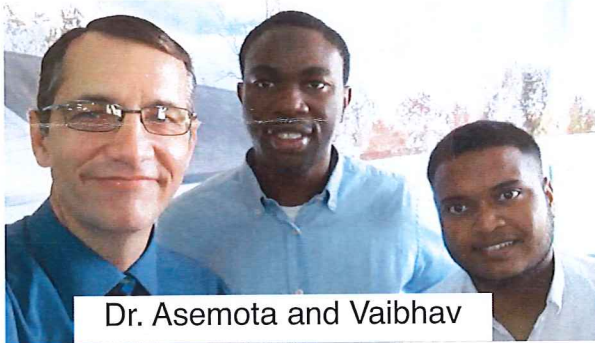
Promise commitments for this year are about \$6,000USD. I am so thankful for the response of our people to the preaching of His Word.
