5. Opportunities to minister to families here.

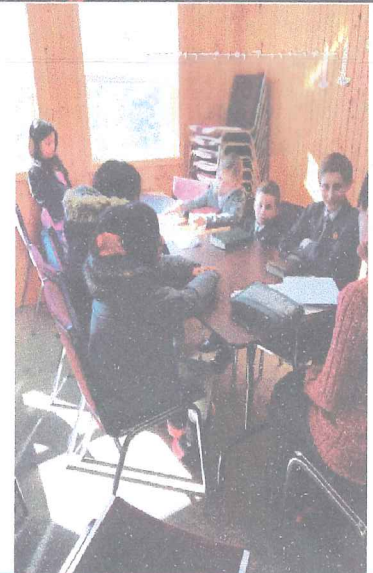
## We ask prayer for:
