

have been back. The owners of the store we shop at knew Caleb well and were quite sad when we told them that he would not be coming back to Nepal for a long time.

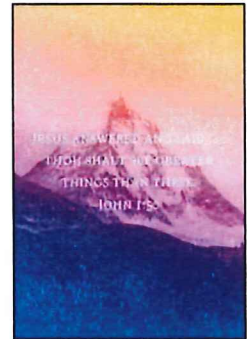


My New Muslim Friend

A FEW DAYS IN DOHA, QATAR: We had the privilege of spending four days in Qatar with friends of ours from Nepal. Kumar and Surmila have been a part of our lives for several years now. Kumar was my right hand for three years. His main job, among many others, was translating for me. Surmila was our neighbor for five years and we built a relationship with her that has lasted. It did cost me my translator, however. Surmila was saved and her and Kumar later married. They now live in Doha. We were able to spend some sweet fellowship with them and around the Word of God. We were unable to contact a church that we found out was there, but are hopeful that Kumar and Surmila will soon make contact and have a place to grow and fellowship. Qatar is, of course, a Muslim country and having a church in any other place except in the one designated area is illegal. We did meet some people along the way. I

was able to witness to a Muslim man from Bangladesh and was able to spend some time discussing doctrine with a saved man named, Joseph, from India. It was a blessed time.

HOME CHURCH: We want to take this time to thank the Lord for our pastor Bro. Wade Cash and his wife Alishia, as well as our home church. We are excited about all the Lord is doing at Gospel Light Baptist Church in Jackson, TN. The church is growing and the Lord is doing great things.
